



Ballasts

NOTICE:

Ballasts manufactured prior to 1979 contain PCB's. Ballasts manufactured after 7/1/78, that do not contain PCB's, are required to be labeled "No PCB'S". Ballasts that do not contain the "No PCB" marking are classified as PCB ballasts.

Non-PCB Ballasts

- Attach NLR "Non-PCB Ballasts Wastes" Label
- Complete Accumulation Date
- Load Container with Intact Ballasts Only
- No Other Wastes Permitted
- Keep Container Closed AT ALL TIMES
- Train Employees
- Maintain Copies of Shipping Paperwork

PCB Ballasts

- Attach NLR "PCB Ballasts Waste" Label
- Complete Accumulation Date
- Load Container with Intact "Non-Leaking" Ballasts Only*
- No Other Wastes Permitted
- Keep Container Closed AT ALL TIMES
- Train Employees
- Use Manifest for shipment
- Maintain Copies of Shipping Paperwork

* If a PCB Ballast is leaking immediately place it into a leak proof container. Additional regulations will apply. Contact NLR for additional information.
